Free mammograms are offered on the third Wednesday of every month from 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM.

Pre-registration is required. If you're uninsured or underinsured, call 302-744-6752 for Kent County or 302-430-5064 for Sussex County. Please note that these are just a few examples, and there may be other providers in Delaware that offer free mammograms.

If you would like to schedule at one of our other convenient imaging locations, please call 302-838-3088 or toll-free 877-838-3088.

Are You Eligible for Free or Low-Cost Screenings? You may be eligible for free or low-cost screenings if you meet these qualifications—

You have no insurance, or your insurance does not cover screening exams. Your yearly income is at or below 250% of the federal poverty level. You are between 40 and 64 years of age for breast cancer screening. You are between 21 and 64 years of age for cervical cancer screening. Certain women who are younger or older may qualify for screening services.
