PAL was founded in 1914 by Captain John Sweeney, a New York City Commanding officer. Since our opening in Wilmington in 2002, we have remained committed to providing our youth a safe haven to go afterschool to channel their energies in positive directions in order to promote self-esteem, good character, life choices and healthy lifestyles.

# WHAT WE DO

Our organization has a full time police officer and dedicated staff who work to enhance the positive moral development of our youth throug a large variety of *Education, Prevention and Athletic*Programs.

- Our organization has served over 42,000 youth in Wilmington & New Castle County in our 23 years of service.
- Education Early Learning, Out of School Time, and Summer Enrichment since 2010 has served 450 youth per year and 7,000 since existence.
- Prevention & Athletics Youth served through our general programming has served 1,500 per year and 35,000 youth served.
